UUFLG BOARD MEETING MINUTES JANUARY 27, 2016

ATTENDEES: Jim Beebe (President), Ann Campbell (Treasurer), Edy Young (Member-at-Large), Ellen Hill, Harry Campbell, Justin Quan

The meeting began at 7:05 PM.

- 1. <u>Eagle Scout Project</u>: Justin Quan presented his project to build a Fellowship sign on the Blossom Hill Road side of our property. He answered many questions during the Board's discussion, after which option #3 of Justin's project was approved with a unanimous vote.
- 2. Financial Status: Ann led a discussion including the following items:
 - a. Fundraising is a \$5000 exposure and our biggest challenge this year.
 - b. Nobody has volunteered to put on the Auction this year.
 - c. We are saving a substantial amount of money due to the lack of a DRE and an Office Administrator.
 - d. Jim indicated he would like one or few numbers that indicate the Fellowship's financial status, if possible.
 - e. Our contribution to Second Harvest from our December "Share the Plate" was \$418.
- 3. <u>UUA Congregational Data</u>: Harry Campbell presented the attached report for 2016. The number of our members (72) was discussed.
- 4. <u>Voting Place</u>: The Registrar of Voters would like to use our Fellowship for both the primary and general (Fall) elections. The Board agreed. Jim Beebe will coordinate this.
- 5. <u>Cracks in the parking lot</u>: Jim reported that the contractor will fix fill and seal the cracks, but a date has yet to be set.
- 6. Welcoming Congregation:
 - a. Edy thought Rev. Fa Jun was coordinating this for the Fellowship.
 - b. She thinks changes in our Bylaws and Mission Statement may be required.
 - c. A working group to address this was proposed to do the actions required for certification by the UUA.
 - d. The question was raised if Welcoming Congregation items were in our curriculum.
 - e. The proposed members of the working group are Karen O'Brien, Sue Ann Lorig, Lance Jacobson and Cindy Giesing. It was decided to organize a "kickoff" meeting in the near future, and the board will coordinate this with Rev. Fa Jun.
- 7. <u>Ordination</u>: The process for the Fellowship was discussed. Jim will contact Rev. Fa Jun about unexpected possible consequences of his ordination.
- 8. <u>Elevator Speeches</u>: To encourage members to develop their own, Jim handed out the UUA pamphlet about brief response to the question "What's Unitarian Universalism?"
- 9. <u>Open Board Positions</u> (VP and Secretary): Lance Jacobson and Lynn Golbetz were proposed as possible candidates. Ann will convey the Board's unanimous approval of this invitation to them.
- 10. <u>Fellowship's Gardener</u>: Nobody has seen or talked to Noe Jamenez in quite some time. Jim will contact him about duties.
- 11. <u>Naming Fellowship Rooms</u>: Discussed renaming the East or West Rooms in the honor of someone who makes a very substantial contribution to the Fellowship. Such action would be considered by the Fellowship.
- 12. Offertory: Jim discussed the book "Not Your Parent's Offering Plate." All Board members were asked to read it.
- 13. <u>Habitat for Humanity's Playhouse Program</u>: Jim and Edy discussed it as a possible outreach program for us.
