### What is Supported Decision-Making?

Supported decision-making, or SDM, is what we all do everyday. We choose trusted doctors, mechanics, attorneys or mentors to assist us in making choices using plain language. For this, we are seen as *wise*. Unfortunately, this is not true for people with disabilities who are often held to the "Dr. Spock Standard" when they ask for help. In fact, people with disabilities most often funnel through an automated pipeline from their school or regional center to conservatorship. Parents and service providers overwhelmingly learn about the most restrictive and, seemingly, the "only" option to support a person with a disability. One option by definition is not a choice.

Everyone – including people with intellectual and developmental disabilities and those who use augmentative and alternative communication – can practice self-determination and SDM by making choices with the help of trusted supporters, family, friends and professionals chosen by the individual.

Our guest speaker Suzanne Bennett Francisco is a single mother of three joyful young adults – Kiely, Brandon and Blake – who have autism and congenital muscular dystrophy (CMD) and who use augmentative alternative communication (AAC). As president and CEO of Exceptional Rights Advocacy, she offers special education and disability rights support. Suzanne also speaks with a focus on SDM, an alternative to conservatorship that empowers people with disabilities without the removal of civil and human rights.


