How to Not Appropriate Dr. King

The Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King was prolific, and many of his words speak directly to the heart of universal human struggles and common values. It may be tempting to use his words to argue for whatever point of view *we* wish to put forward, such as when his calls for nonviolence are used as a way for light-skinned folks to "tone-police" people of color. Today we'll study the words and contexts of Dr. King's ideas and allow them to help us cultivate true kindness and understanding while divesting ourselves from the mistake of coopting them for divisive purposes. –Rev.
