Minutes for 2022 Business Meeting

The Unitarian Universalist Fellowship of Los Gatos held its annual business meeting on June 12, 2022, at 12:30 p.m., with board president Karen O'Brien presiding.

The meeting was called to order at 12:35. A quorum was established.

The motion to exempt Julie Matthews from the following bylaw provision for purposes of this year's election, "All Trustees shall be members of the Fellowship for at least one year," was passed.

The following officers were elected to the board for terms commencing July 1, 2022:

President: Mark Ditzler (one-year term)
Vice President: Karen Fitch (one-year term)
Secretary: Lynn Golbetz (two-year term)
Treasurer: Julie Matthews (two-year term)

Member at Large: Lauri Feetham (two-year term)

Robb Stolberg was elected chair of the Nominating Committee for 2021-23. Christina Morgan was elected a member of the committee. One vacancy remains on this committee.

Julie Matthews reviewed the fellowship's financials and proposed budget and answered questions thereon.

The fellowship passed the budget proposed by the board (attached to these minutes).

Sierra Golbetz moved from the floor that the minimum age for membership in the fellowship be reduced to 16. Mark Ditzler suggested it be 15. As this would be a bylaw amendment, it requires 14 days' advance notice before a vote by the members. The membership approved the following motion:

At least two weeks after circulation of notice, an email vote of the members shall be held to amend Article V, Section 1, of the bylaws as follows:

"This society shall welcome into membership any person who supports the purposes stated above, is either at least eighteen fifteen years of age or has completed the Coming of Age program, and who has signed the membership book."

Lynn Golbetz will circulate the aforementioned notice.

The meeting was adjourned at 1:05 p.m.
