Constitution Day and Citizenship Day, Saturday, September 17

On September 17, 1787, the Founding Fathers signed the <u>US Constitution</u>. For 235 years, the Constitution has served as the supreme law of the land. The Constitution, along with the Bill of Rights and other amendments, structure our government and guarantee our rights. Each year, on September 17, Americans recognize Constitution Day and Citizenship Day.

A great way to live the principles of our constitutional democracy is to support <u>Move</u> to <u>Amend</u>, a grass-roots organization of citizens working to amend the Constitution to end corporate rule and legalize democracy by firmly establishing that money is not speech, and that human beings, not corporations, are persons entitled to

constitutional rights. Move to Amend asserts that the Supreme Court is misguided in principle, and wrong on the law. In a democracy, the people rule.
